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Young couples, the moment you become, the moment you get married and you are setting up your own home, it is as if your own home must be bigger than any home before you. You must have what mom and dad, what they have got. And so you work really hard at it, and to make money, and you make plenty of it, but for the wrong reason.

And often in trying to make that, you fail in many other areas. You work, and work, and work, and work. You become a workaholic.

You work, and work, and work. You give all your life to it because you want to make it, and then you have lost some other important things in life. Oh God, help us tonight to be so set free from material bondage.

Number two principle, God cares and provides for his own. God cares and he provides for his own. Notice in the passage we have read, verse 27, consider how the lilies grow.

They do not labor or spin, yet I tell you, not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. And if that is how God clothes the grass of the field which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, how much more will he clothe you? Oh you of little faith. God cares.

God provides. And the provision of God does not depend upon how much you try. No, it is not of him that willeth, it is not of him that worketh, but of the Lord that showeth grace and mercy.

You cannot make what you want to make of yourself by yourself unless God makes of you what he wants to make of you. What do you have that has not been given to you? What will you ever have that will not be given to you? Why don't you look to God for his provision and stop struggling. I see freedom from material bondage.

It is not so much that we provide for ourselves, God is the one who provides. And you know one thing, I have found him to be a great provider. His name is Jehovah Jireh, the God who provides.

While I was here in Canada for about 10 years, lived in Kitchener, lived in Toronto, I lived in Vancouver and God provided wonderfully. I had all I needed, even more than I needed. Then I sensed the call of God upon my life to go back to Nigeria.

I didn't go to Nigeria because I am from Nigeria. I had the choice, by the grace of God, to stay here. I had the choice, I cooled off.

And my wife did not go to Nigeria with me simply because my husband is from Nigeria. We sought that face of God. Lord, where is your ministry for us? We want to serve you and we felt called of God to move to Nigeria to serve God and thank God for the ministry he has given to us there.

We could have done otherwise. We could have looked for some other things that will help us in life. Time will not permit me, I can begin to speak of how much I earn and how much we make.

And when you begin to turn that into dollars, what it comes to in a month? \$100 a month. Combine the two salaries together, \$100 a month. That's equivalent in Naira.

But we knew that God had called. It was not easy to decide to go because I knew very well that where I had been all along, God had been providing. What will happen when I get to Nigeria? You know what we did? We bought all we could buy to take to Nigeria.

There were boxes and boxes and boxes. And when we got there, we realized that we took there what we did not need, that great provider. He can provide for you anywhere.

And I came to a realization that that God who had provided for me is that God that will provide for us in Nigeria. We took food along as if there would be no food in Nigeria. When we got to Nigeria, we found out that we could eat what they eat there.

And that was what we were trying to avoid too. And my wife enjoys Nigerian food more than I even enjoy it. She's not a Nigerian.

And God has provided. He has proved himself to be faithful. And that's why I am calling you tonight, even in our time together this week, that exercise faith in God.

He's the faithful one. So unchanging. Ageless one.

Our rock. Our refuge. Our strength.

He's the one that we can count upon. We can depend on him. He's the God for all time.

He's the God for all place. He is the God for every situation. He's the great provider.

He'll provide for you. He says here, consider the ribbons. Verse 24, the animals.

Go to the animal kingdom and see how God provides for them. And if God can provide for the animals, he will provide for human beings. But not just human beings.

Human beings that have come into a special relationship with him. His children. Don't you provide for your children? Then he says, well, if you cannot learn from the animal kingdom, let us try vegetation.

Verse 27, consider the lilies. God provides. So if God provides, relax.

Relax. Bothering yourself. And let God do for you what you cannot do for yourself.

That's the point. Trust him. Do you remember a man by the name of Elijah? How God provided for him.

God asked him to do certain things. And by the way, God asked him to pray that there would be no rain. And there was no rain in the land.

I'm not so sure if God asked Reverend Fred and I to pray yesterday that there would be no rain in the afternoon yesterday. But there was rain. We prayed that there should be rain.

And there was rain. So that people will come to the service in the afternoon and they will not go to the beach. Now you know that God hears and answers our prayers.

The rain continued all day yesterday. And I was beginning to wonder if the rain would stop. Now you know that Reverend Fred and I, we have been on our knees all night praying that the rain will stop.

And the rain stopped this morning. Well let's go back on our knees tonight and pray that tomorrow will be real sunshine. Now better be careful.

Otherwise they begin to test the power of our prayer. Elijah prayed that there will be no rain in the land. And because there was no rain in the land, there was famine.

Great starvation. But God was able to feed Elijah. Guess what God used? The ravens.

The animal. Morning after morning the animal will come and bring food to Elijah. And then when the water dried up, God said to Elijah, I have prepared a woman for you.

A woman. A widow. And guess what that woman had? Her last meal.

Her last supper. And God said to Elijah, I have prepared a widow for you to feed you for days. Feed you for days with her last supper.

Oh yes. God did it. Little went a long way.

Have you got little? Or you say you've got nothing? Our God provides. He's that great provider. Relax.

Oh it is economic recession. Things are not working out well. Oh I may lose my job.

Oh I may not be able to pay the bills. You are getting into some kind of financial bondage. Material bondage.

You are always concerned about money. You are always talking about not being able to do this or do that. You are concerned about how hard it may get later on.

Relax. Our God provides. He's that great provider.

Third principle. I'm rounding up. Reverend Fred said that I preached for one hour.

I want to prove him wrong tonight. Third principle. Worry will give you something to do, but it

will not get you anywhere.

Did you hear that? Hello? Are you still there? It's not nine o'clock yet, so it cannot be your bedtime now. And don't forget what I said yesterday. If you find somebody trying to sleep, just tap that person on the shoulder.

And if you can signal to me, I'll raise my voice here to wake that person up. Worry will give you something to do, but it will not get you anywhere. It's there in the passage.

Verse 25. Who of you, by worrying, can add a single hour to your life? Since you cannot do this very little thing, why do you worry about the rest? And many of us, we worry too much about the bills. We worry too much about what we are going to achieve, what we are going to make.

We worry too much about the material. And God is saying to us tonight, relax. You know one thing about worry? Worry is like a merry-go-round ride.

It will take you round and round and round and round and round, but it won't get you anywhere. They used to have the one that goes round like this. Now they have added to that.

Did you notice technology? And so they have the one that goes up and down. Up, down, up, down, up, down, up, down. It won't get you anywhere you are coming down.

That's worry. It will take you all over the place, but it will not get you anywhere. So why worry about the material? I say have faith in God.

Faith in God will set you free. It will set you free from material bondage and life will be wonderful for you. They will say, how can you be so much at peace when there is not so much for you to eat? You say, I'm at ease.

Why will I worry when I know that his eyes are on the sparrows and I know he cares for me. Have you come to that place? God help us tonight. I finish with the last principle.

To get the best and to make the most out of life, make sure that your priorities are well placed. To get the best and to make the most out of life, make sure that your priorities are well placed. Verse 29, verse 29.

Do not set your heart on what you will eat or drink. Do not worry about it, for the pagan world runs after all such things and your father knows that you need them. But seek first, seek first the kingdom of God and all these things shall be added to you.

But seek first the kingdom of God. What are you running after? Where is your heart tonight? Is your heart with God? Is your heart fixed on God or is your heart fixed on something else? Where is your faith tonight? Is your faith in God through Jesus Christ or in something else? It says seek first and what we are called upon to seek first is what many people seek last. It says if you seek first the kingdom of God, all these other things will be added unto you.

So you seek all these other things and then you seek God last. What a misplaced priority. We were praying for somebody not too long ago in Nigeria in our church that God will give a job to him and you know God gives jobs and when he gives nobody can take it away from you unless he allows it to be taken away and if it is taken away he knows what to do with it.

So we prayed and God provided a job for the young man and the moment God provided a job he got so busy and he was busy. He used to come to the prayer meeting to pray for the job and the moment he got the job and he got so busy no time for prayer meeting, no time for church, no time for fellowship, no time for many other things because he's putting the last first and I cornered him in the church one day. Where have you been? What's going on? I hardly see you again.

I said wait a minute I'm going to change my prayers. I'm going to pray that God will take that job away from you and I don't need to pray that he can do it if he wants to because when the priorities are misplaced God will correct us and when a people have been so blessed with material possession and when their faith is not properly focused God will chastise. When we shift our focus from him to something else and whatever it is that stands in the way of faith in God, God will remove it.

You better ship up then. You better get your priority right because God will not allow anything else to compete with him and you'll be glad that he takes it away so that you can gain heaven, so that you can gain peace, so that you can gain joy because when you have these other things you are not even at peace, you are not even at rest. So why not seek first the kingdom of God, seek the Lord, serve the Lord, trust the Lord and don't allow yourself to be distracted by whatever that may be.

In Nigeria, those of us who work in Nigeria we have what we call fringe benefits. I don't know maybe you have that here too. There are some kind of allowances and as for me as a pastor I have what we call fringe benefits.

Now if they don't do that to the pastors here I'm going to make a little promotion here right now and that is to say that first of all you pay the salary of your pastor and after paying the salary of your pastor you give allowances such as traveling allowance. Whenever you travel, whether you travel or not the allowance will be given to you. Such as hospitality allowance.

I get that whether I have them in my home and entertain them or not is a fringe benefit. Remember it is added to my salary even now I'm getting it. I get my salary so whenever I get my salary I get the fringe benefit.

You know why? As long as I'm their pastor, as long as I am on the payroll, as long as I am drawing my salary I will get the fringe benefits. I don't run after the fringe benefits. I run after being their staff.

I run after being on the payroll and as long as I am there on the payroll my name appears every

month. I get my fringe benefits. Seek God.

Seek God. Be in touch with him. Be in fellowship with him.

Let your relationship with him be so dynamic. Be so living and other things will be added unto you. Oh God help us to not misplace our priorities.

Are you here tonight? You are in bondage. Hello? I just want to be sure again because I'm rounding up. I want to be sure you are still there and you are still on the line because we are communicating now.

Are you here tonight? I've been talking about your life you say. That yes for you it has appeared as if all that matters is material. For you you have not come to the place of knowing that God provides and God really cares.

For you you have allowed anxiety and worry and the cares of life to push you all over the place. Or for you you have misplaced your priority and God says tonight come back to me. Put your faith and your trust in me.

Or you are here tonight you say brother Lupitas I don't have any material bondage but you know I have other bondages. I've only used this one to make my point and to see that this could be applied to other areas of life. If you exercise faith in God whatever it is that is giving you emotional problem.

Whatever it is that has brought emotional problem to your life and you are in bondage to sorrow. You are in bondage to fear and other things. I said tonight God cares.

I said tonight take your eyes off your problems and let your focus be on God. Often we are looking too much at the problems and it becomes a mountain to us. Why don't you allow the wings of faith to lift you up tonight and stand from above and look down on the problems.

Or is this something that the wicked one is doing to you? And you say Lord I need help to be delivered from evil. Exercise faith in God whatever your bondage may be. I say tonight if the son of God has made you free you shall be free indeed.

Let's bow together for the prayer of liberty. A prayer of setting free and I want you to look up to the Lord. Whatever your situation may be and those who know how to pray please pray.

You may be praying for yourself and you may be praying for somebody else. You say have your own way Lord. Have your own way.

and make me after thy way once more please His will for you is to have life in abundance. His will for you is to have liberty to be set free. But exercise faith tonight and once again tonight you are called upon to break out of the crowd.

To say yes Lord while you are passing by tonight do not pass me by. Lord I need your attention.

Lord I need your attention and if you need his attention you have to get it.

You have to say yes Lord look upon me. Yes Lord I need you. It is a personal response and we're not ashamed in the presence of God.

We're not filled with pride here tonight. We're open to God and God is open to us and we want to pray for one another. That's all we're doing now.

We are spending time in prayer for one another. We are responding to God and God will respond to us when we look up to him by faith. You are here tonight.

You say brother Lupitas. Oh yes material bondage. I have not been able to get away from it.

Oh God help me tonight. You are here tonight. You say I thank God that I know that he so cares because I'm trusting him tonight for a particular provision.

What is that provision that you are looking for? Or you are here tonight you say yes brother Lupitas. I have misplaced my priority and I want to get back to him tonight. I come back to him.

Lord help me to properly look up to you. Oh God help me tonight. I want to pray with you.

I want to pray for you and there are several people who will be praying along with me for you tonight. Or you say tonight brother Lupitas. I'm so sad.

I'm so depressed. I have this emotional problem. I cannot get away from it.

Lord tonight set me free as I look to you by faith. Or you are here tonight. You sense what that wicked one has been doing in your life.

God will help you. This is why the son of God came. He came to destroy the works of the devil.

He came to set captives free. That's why Jesus came. He will set you free tonight but you must exercise faith in the living God through the Lord Jesus Christ.

We are not just having a physical exercise when we ask people to stand up. That's not what we're doing. We are standing up and whatever it is in us must stand up tonight.

It must stand up tonight. It must be brought to God tonight. It must be lifted up tonight because the bible tells me that when we call upon the name of Jesus and when Jesus is lifted up he will draw all unto himself.

As Jesus is lifted up tonight let whatever it is be lifted up with Jesus tonight so that God can give proper attention. If you are I've been talking as I felt led by the spirit of God and if there's any any knowledge God will give to me I will call you. I will tell you your problem and you will respond unto the Lord.

But so far wherever you are just rise up on your feet now and say yes brother Lou Peters. I look

for that. But your trip to heaven because if you are to go to Nigeria you have to be able to shout hallelujah like they shout hallelujah in Nigeria.

And if you are going to be in heaven with us you have to be able to shout hallelujah with us in heaven. I wonder if there will be a piano in heaven. Would you like to play piano in heaven? I want to be there.

And if there will be a hallelujah chorus in heaven too I would like to lead that hallelujah chorus. As I told you Reverend Lloyd Price is doing very well. I'm going to give a good recommendation for him too.

Amen. Praise the Lord. We bless the Lord for the way he had been ministering to us.

And one thing about our God is that he does much more than what we ask. Much more than what we think. Much more than what we desire.

And often God is full of pleasant surprises. You start something with God you'll never know where you are going to land. And it's always good to know that God is at work in us and through us.

It was about 17 years ago when I first walked into a missionary church in Toronto. Reverend David Illman was the pastor then of the St. Clair Missionary Church. And I don't think that I knew what I was in for even back then.

But I thank God I've been able to stay with the missionary church and thank God for being part of the missionary church. And it was the missionary church that recommended me by the way to the missionary church in Nigeria. Because I did not grow up in the missionary church in Nigeria.

I grew up in another church entirely and I didn't know the Lord all the time I was in Nigeria. It was when I left home in 1974 while I was in Europe that I came into a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. I left home to study accounting and somehow it all got changed.

I studied theology instead. And instead of keeping books God has given me the privilege of keeping souls. Isn't that wonderful? And when I started I didn't know what I was getting into.

God is full of surprises and we bless his name. I also remember close to about 10 years ago I met a young girl and when I first heard of her I did not want to meet her because somebody was playing a game. Matchmaking.

And I thought at that particular time I was old enough to find a wife for myself. And the young lady knew too that somebody was playing a game so we were trying to avoid each other. And we did that for a long time until conviction came upon me from the Lord.

I looked at Reverend Priddle there. You will remember too 17 years ago when I first walked into your office at Emmanuel Bible College. But let me go back to the other story.

I met this girl later on and it was on a blind date. Okay some of you are wondering how on earth Olu Peters and Tracy Peters came together. It was on a blind date and for a long time I kept my eyes in the books.

Theological books. Then I felt that I should open my eyes and observe some wonderful things that God has created. And Tracy happened to be one of those wonderful creatures of God.

So we went out on a blind date. We had never met before. We talked on the phone because there was a friend organizing everything.

So I got to her door. I said who are you? She said I am Tracy Times. That was in Toronto over 10 years ago now.

And she said to me who are you? I am Olu Peters. So we went out that night and as we were going out I noticed for the first time in my life that I was going out with a girl taller than me. They have always looked up to me.

Now I had to look up to somebody else. And I did my very best that evening to keep up with her. You know what I did? I was galloping and I was going like that trying to keep up with her.

And little did I realize that I would be galloping for the rest of my life. I told you you start something you don't know where you are going to end up. Thank God for his goodness to us.

Praise the Lord. Bless the name of Jesus. Praise the name of Jesus.

He is my trust. He is the name. Let's rise up together to bless the Lord together.

Just bless the Lord where you are. Offer a word of praise to God for who he is, for what he had meant to you, for what he had done in your life. Just give thanks to the Lord.

Give praise to him. Express your gratitude unto God. Has the Lord been good to you in our time together so far? Say thank you Lord for being so good to me.

Bless you Lord. We worship you Lord. Father, accept our praises.

Accept our gratitude and continue Lord to show your goodness unto us. Bless in the rest of the service this evening. You are the speaker.

Speak to us by the power of your spirit and cause us to give the appropriate response again tonight. For we ask in the name of Jesus Christ. Amen.

God's people say we're back again to the subject of the Christian faith and that is what we have been discussing since Friday night. The Christian faith and the difference that the Christian faith makes in the life of the one that is ready to trust the living God. We have discussed so far the importance of such faith.

The need for us to exercise such faith in the living God and we have been trying to get across to

you some of the things that faith in God will do in the life of the one that is ready to trust God. Two nights ago we were able to discover as we entered the workshop of faith and we're still there because it is in the workshop of faith that you can begin to see the works of faith. So two nights ago as we were in the workshop of faith we were able to see a man by the name of Noah at work in that workshop and we were able to see that indeed faith in God is able to save, it is able to sanctify and it is able to set apart.

The faith that saves you from hell is the faith that will sanctify you for heaven. And just last night we were able to see from the faith of Abraham that when you exercise faith in the living God that faith is able to sustain you. That faith is able to strengthen you.

That faith is able to support you in whatever you are going through in life. And we found out last night that it is not so much what you are going through in life but who goes through it with you. And with faith in God life can be so exciting.

With faith in God life can be so wonderful regardless of what you are going through. We found that last night. Tonight we are going to see that faith in God is able to set free.

Faith in God is able to set free. And when the Lord Jesus Christ came he said I have come that you might have life and that you might have life in abundance. And my desire tonight is that he will give life unto us.

It is also said that if the son of God has made you free you shall be free indeed. And it is unfortunate to realize that there are many Christians who are going around but they are not living the life of liberty. There are many so-called Christians who are bound by one thing or the other.

It is interesting to notice that when the Lord spoke to Lazarus and he said to Lazarus when Lazarus was in the grave and Lazarus had been there for about four days. He spoke to Lazarus and said Lazarus come out. Lazarus came out.

But you will notice that when Lazarus came out Lazarus was still having that grave clothes. He could not move around. Lazarus was still bound.

Yes Lazarus had life but Lazarus did not have liberty. And so many Christians are like that. They have life but they don't have liberty.

It is a contradiction. And God will want to move us on tonight to liberty if the son of God has given life to you. So Jesus said to them set him loose.

And they did. They took that grave clothes away from Lazarus and Lazarus was able to move around. And that's why God has recreated us.

He has recreated us through his son not only for life he has recreated us for liberty. If the son of God has made you free you shall be free indeed. And the message tonight is that faith in God

can set you free.

There are many bondages. There is the what I call spiritual bondage. And there are many who are in spiritual bondage.

They are chained. They are bound in the world of their spirits. And often it is demonic bondage.

Satanic bondage. Time will not permit me. I will have love to go into that.

And then we'll be talking about spiritual warfare which is a reality by the way. Because our wrestle is not against flesh and blood. It is against forces.

Spiritual powers in the heavenly places and such powers such forces are wicked. And many people are bound. Non-Christians yes they are bound.

But many Christians they are often influenced and oppressed by satanic attack and demonic oppression. And the message tonight is that faith in God can set you loose. Can set you free from that.

There is an emotional bondage. People often go into a time of depression. I don't know what may have been the cause of that.

And many things are responsible for that. But that wicked one is one that will always want to take an advantage. And he will use situations in your life.

He will use experiences in your life to bring you into a kind of emotional bondage. It can be sorrow. It can be great depression.

And the message again tonight is that if the son of God has made you free you shall be free indeed. Faith in God will set you free even tonight. There are other bondages.

There is what I call material bondage. When people are in bondage to materialism. When people are in bondage to the cares of this life.

When people are in bondage to the anxieties and the worries of this life. And often people are. And there is freedom for such people tonight.

And in fact what I really want to address will be this tonight. Faith in God can set you free from material bondage. And then we will try to see how we can apply that to other areas where people are in bondage.

Faith in God can set you free from material bondage. Turn with me to the gospel of Luke for good news tonight. The gospel of Luke chapter 12 beginning with verse 22 for good news tonight.

Luke chapter 12 beginning with verse 22. I'll read few verses and then we will go on to pick out from this passage some principles. Some principles that will help us to begin to exercise the

kind of faith that sets free particularly from material bondage.

Jesus said to his disciples. Therefore I tell you do not worry about your life. What you will eat or about your body.

What you will wear. Life is more than food and the body more than clothes. Consider the ravens.

They do not sow or reap. They have no storeroom or barn. Yet God feeds them.

And how much more valuable you are than birds. Who of you by worrying can add a single hour to his life. Since you cannot do this very little thing.

Why do you worry about the rest. Consider how the lilies grow. They do not labor or spin.

Yet I tell you not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. If that is how God clothes the grass of the field which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the fire. How much more will he clothe you.

Oh you of little faith. Oh you of little faith. Why do you get so much distracted by the cares, by the worries, by the anxieties of life.

Oh you of little faith. If you will exercise enough faith in God it will set you free from material bondage. Four principles.

Number one. There is more to life than the material. There is more to life than the material.

Verse 23. Life is more than food and the body is more than clothes. Materialism is a terrible problem to many people.

The pursuit of accumulating, the pursuit of achieving, the pursuit of building, the pursuit of acquiring. And people will spend the best time in their lives pursuing the material. We've got to be like the Joneses they say.

We must have this, we must have that. Who tells you you must. And the whole of life is spent on achieving and accumulating so many material things.

Many people will spend more time in the physical, in the material than they spend in the spiritual. There are many rich people in the Bible. The Bible talked about several of them who were rich.

Abraham was a rich man. And there were some other rich people that were mentioned in the New Testament too. But there was this rich fool.

A rich man but he was a fool. He spent almost his life accumulating. He spent his life pursuing the material.

Luke chapter 12 verses 13 to 21. It is the passage just before the one that we are talking about. And it now puts what we are saying tonight in its proper context.

The rich fool. He thought he was rich. He has spent his life trying to do this, trying to do that.

He's been able to build a big barn, a big storage. After all, that is what he has been able to achieve. Then he said to himself in verse 17, what shall I do? I have no place to store my crops.

Then he said to himself, this is what I will do. I will tear down my barns and I will build a bigger one. And there I will store all my grain and my goods.

And I'll say to myself, you have plenty of good things laid out for many years. Take life easy. Eat, drink, and be merry.

And often that is what people go about doing. They collect, they make so much money and they enjoy themselves. And so much is spent on themselves.

And then if they want to ease their own conscience, you know what they do. Let's go to the Salvation Army. And let's give them some clothes and some furnishings.

Hello? Hello? I just want to be sure you are still with me and that you are still on the line. Am I communicating? You spend so much time acquiring. And then when you have so much, you've got a problem in your hands.

You look for where to keep them. You don't even know where to keep them. So you throw them away.

And often the generation becomes the generation of throwaway. God have mercy on us. It is not a sin to be blessed.

It is not a sin to have things in abundance. But if care is not taken, we may be putting our faith in the wrong objects. We may be looking for other substitutes.

We want to acquire this. We want to achieve this. And our faith is in what we've got.

Listen to what Jesus says in verse 15. Verse 15 of that Luke chapter 12. He said to them, watch out.

Be on your guard against all kinds of greed. A man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions. Possessions.

There is more to life than the material. What do you have? What are you running after? What have you been able to achieve? What will you ever be able to achieve in the material? What are you going to do with that? If you don't throw away some of them now, you will leave them behind anyway. They will all be left behind.

You won't take anything anywhere. One man died and several people were interested in what

the man left behind. And so they began to ask the question, where is the will? How much did he leave behind? Some of the people that were interested in what will come to them quickly went to the man that was in charge of executing that will.

And he turned out to be a minister of God. They asked him this question, how much? They wanted to know how much. You know what he said? He said everything.

Everything you will leave behind. You will not take anything with you. In fact, whatever is put on you, whatever is put in that coffin, you will still leave that behind.

And if you spend your whole life pursuing that, accumulating that, and reveling in that, you will leave all that behind. And you have nothing to show for it. Billy Graham said on one occasion, if you cannot take everything with you, you can send as much as you can ahead of you.

And that makes a difference. Do you have such faith in God that has set you free from material bondage? That there is more to life than the material. And some of us, it is food for us.

We eat and eat and eat and eat and eat. And thank God for food. Thank God for the abundance of food.

But when you eat so much, and what you have eaten becomes another problem for you, you have to begin to think of how you can shed off the weight. Isn't that something? Why don't you leave food alone? And then food will leave you alone. There's liberty for you tonight.

There is freedom for you tonight. There is that kind of faith in God that will set you free tonight. Because there are people like that.

I know for some people, whatever they eat, it will be a problem. There are people like that because of their constitution. I said again tonight too, there is faith that will set you free from that.

Because you will eat, and what you eat will be good for you. But it is by faith in the living God. There is more to life than the material.
